NuTone Heating and Cooling Products Warranty One of the Best in the Industry
Warranty includes 10 years on all parts and 10-year NuTone Quality Pledge

DAYTON, Ohio, June 1, 2009 - It's a pretty safe bet that consumers today are looking for the best value in the products and services they buy. A case in point is [NuTone Heating and Cooling products](#), especially when it comes to the warranty on its products. WinWholesale, the HVAC line's exclusive distributor through its [Noland Company](#), and [Winair](#) and [Winnelson](#) brands, says the warranty is one of the best in the industry.

The nationwide distributor's dealers seem to agree.

"What makes NuTone easier to sell initially are the quality assurance and warranty," said Greg Maynard, owner/operator of Tri-County Heating & Cooling in Hendersonville, Tenn. "Once we explain the warranty and that NuTone is willing to stand behind it for ten years people want to know more about it."

After the consumer registers the product, NuTone's warranty provisions are:

- 10 years on all parts
- Limited lifetime heat exchanger warranty
- 10 years on indoor air quality products and zoning products when installed with a new NuTone system
- 10-year NuTone Quality Pledge

Under the Quality Pledge, if the heat exchanger or compressor fail within the first ten years after registration (or five years if not registered), NuTone will replace the product with a like product. NuTone also pays the dealer \$250 towards labor to replace the unit.

Dealers report a lack of warranty calls from customers on NuTone equipment, according to WinWholesale officials.

Said Patrick Eubanks of Eubanks Mechanical in Greenville, N.C., "When you couple no warranty calls with the ten-year warranty, we have a lot of satisfied customers, and word spreads quickly."
